Why: Go back to your childhood days of excellent homecooked dishes served in a casual environment at reasonable prices.
CLEO's pick: The Braised Tofu with Crystal Prawns, \$18, is mouth-wateringly good while the Braised Vermicelli with Pork Trotters, \$12, is aromatic and tasty. Wash it all down with a glass of refreshing Lemongrass & Passionfruit Iced Tea, \$4.20.

◀ Din Tai Fung Paragon
Why: It's the first place outside of Taiwan to serve the new Mini Steamed Pork Dumplings, or Xiao Long Tang Bao.
CLEO's pick: The Xiao Long Tang Buns, \$10.80 for 10, are half the size of regular xiao long buns, and are served with a bowl of chicken broth for you to dip into.
